WHITE SOX ANNOUNCE 2009 SPRING TRAINING BROADCAST SCHEDULE

CHICAGO – The Chicago White Sox, Comcast SportsNet, WGN-TV and WSCR Radio (670 AM) have announced the team's 2009 broadcast schedule for spring training.

The White Sox will televise seven Cactus League games (six on Comcast SportsNet and one on WGN). WSCR, the club's flagship radio station, will air 10 spring training games.

The first televised spring training game by Comcast SportsNet is on Sunday, March 1 at 2:05 p.m. when the White Sox face the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first game at Camelback Ranch-Glendale. In addition to its six live telecasts, Comcast SportsNet will replay four games at 7:00 p.m. CT the same evening (March 21, 24, 26 and April 2). WGN-TV will televise one Cactus League game when the White Sox take on the Dodgers on Saturday, March 28 at 3:05 p.m.

Ken "Hawk" Harrelson and Steve Stone will work all seven games in their first season together as the White Sox television broadcast team. Harrelson is set to begin his 20th season as the television voice of the White Sox, while Stone moves to TV after one season as an analyst on WSCR.

WSCR broadcasts the first of its 10 games on Wednesday, February 25 at 2:05 p.m. when the White Sox open Cactus League play against the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim in Tempe. WSCR will feature the new on-air team of play-by-play voice Ed Farmer and color analyst Darrin Jackson. Farmer begins his 18th full season in the White Sox radio booth and Jackson enters his first after working 10 years on Sox television broadcasts. WSCR's White Sox spring training pre-game show starts 10 minutes before game time and a five-minute postgame show follows each broadcast.
